I. Overview

A. Event name: 2025 Future Leaders' Conference

B. Objectives:

- To cultivate the Korean identity and enhance the capabilities of the future generation overseas Koreans.
- To discover practical solutions for mutual growth and development between the Republic of Korea and the overseas Korean community
- C. Dates: May 27 (Tue) to May 30 (Fri), 2025 < 3 nights, 4 days >
- * Side Event 'FLC Representatives Meeting': May 31(sat) to June 1(Sun), 2025
- D. Location: Incheon and Seoul, Korea

E. Main Program Content

- Discussion and networking session to strengthen the capabilities of future generation Overseas Koreans
 - Discussion of the current situation and key issues within future generation overseas Korean communities in the countries of residence
 - Presentations on regional FLC results and discussions on expanding networks
 - Networking among regional and professional organizations
- Visiting Korean government institutions and meeting with relevant officials
- · Presentation on government policies and projects related to the future generation overseas Koreans
- Side event : FLC Representative Meeting(For representative from '23 to '25)

II. Eligibility and Selection Criteria

A. Eligibility

- Overseas Korean individuals aged between 25 and 45
 - Those who have contributed to the development of the Korean community through their work in various professional fields.
 - Those who work in the field of politics, economics, law, major media, culture, art, or international organizations, etc.,
 - Executives of exemplary organizations of future generation overseas Koreans or professional groups
 - Nominees recommended by Korean diplomatic missions abroad

B. Selection Criteria

- Active involvement in the Korean communities in countries of residence
 - Future generation leader capable of playing a central role in the local Korean community
 - Strong communication skills (in Korean and local language), with pride in being Korean and a positive attitude toward Korean culture
 - Active engagement in fostering Korean identity and strengthening ties with Korea
- Expertise and achievements in their professional field, as well as potential for future growth
- Top nominees recommended by Korean diplomatic missions abroad, etc.

C. Number of Participants

• Approximately 60 participants from overseas

D. Application Period and Method

Application Period

- Application Period: From the announcement date to March 3 (Monday), 2025 (Korean Standard Time)
- Selection Results: Announcement by March 21 (Friday), 2025 (via diplomatic missions and individual notice)

- Complete the application document → Submit the application to the Korean Embassies or Consulates General in your country of residence

- A. Airfare: 50% of round-trip airfare (based on economy class, actual expenses)
- * Airfare Payment Principles
- Airfare will be covered up to a certain limit determined by the Overseas Koreans Agency and any excess amount is the participant's responsibility.

- For the flights with layover in other regions for personal purposes that are not related to conference, the cost of the flights will be borne by participant.
- The maximum amount of airfare coverage by country and region will be informed individually(Only for selected participants.)
- Airfare support is available only for those entering Korea within one week before the conference and departing within one week after the conference.

B. Accommodation

- Accommodation: Double occupancy (For single occupancy, the price difference is at the participant's expense.)
- Meals: 3 meals per day (Only for the conference period. Personal expenses excluded)
