Sejong Cultural Society and Indiana University's National Consortium for Teaching About Asia (NCTA) have partnered to present a virtual workshop on Korea's sijo poetry and literature this summer. Participants will delve into the world of Korean sijo and literature and explore Chinese jueju and Japanese haiku. The workshop will provide valuable insights into teaching strategies for sijo in a school setting and techniques for enhancing and refining sijo writing. Attendees will actively engage in crafting their own sijo compositions and partake in stimulating discussions about lesson plans centered around sijo.
